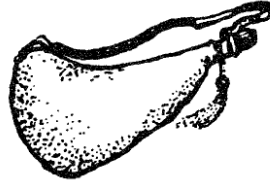


WINESKINS

We would like to tell you about *Wineskins*, a gathering of Jesus' disciples who desire to dialogue about significant Kingdom issues and establish and maintain networks of koinonia within the Body of Christ. We've met twice a year (Spring and Fall) to fellowship and reason together for over 35 years (since 1974).

There is a limit of 44 (forty-four) participants to give all attending a chance to become involved. The conference is not a time for relaxation. We are hard at it with little time provided for leisure. Issues are merely opened up and hammered out with no view of sending everyone home with "THE ANSWER". *Wineskins* is an ecumenical gathering; many different expressions of our faith will be represented, such as Roman Catholics, Presbyterians, Mennonites, Baptists, Episcopalians, etc.

Everyone attending participates in paying for the conference. The speakers are not paid for their participation at the conferences; they are there because they want to be.

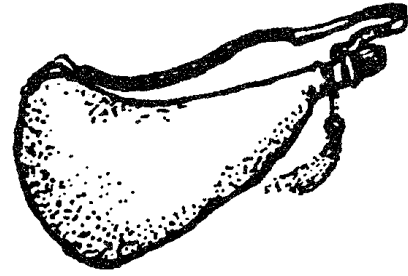

This is a brief letter to make sure your plans include being with us for the next Wineskins fellowship, coming up on November 6-8, 2015.

The conference will begin on Friday, November 6th, at 6 PM; you may check-in beginning at 3 PM on Friday. We will say farewell at 2 PM on Sunday, November 8th. This Wineskins will be held at the Hyatt House in El Segundo, CA (the old Summerfield Suites for you Wineskins veterans). Those of you who are flying in on Friday will want to fly into the Los Angeles International or Long Beach Airports.

We want to reiterate one of our basic requests at Wineskins. To achieve the objectives of koinonia and dialogue, we ask that all participants agree to be *present for the entire conference*. If, for whatever reason, you are unable to commit to the entire conference, please let us know immediately so that someone else may be contacted to take your place. Thank you!

Our cost is \$175.00 per person. A \$100 deposit will hold you a place; first-come, first-served. The cost for full-time college/university students (full time = taking 12 or more units) is \$125.00. Space is limited to 44 participants and many of the past Wineskins have been very full.
